

# English Language Requirements and Recommendations



## Is submitting an English certificate (IELTS) required for admission?

**No**, neither the Ministry of Higher Education nor the Institute requires an IELTS certificate as an official prerequisite for application or admission to the department.



## Recommended (Assumed) Score

The student is expected to possess a linguistic proficiency level equivalent to at least **4.5 - 5.0** in the IELTS test (High Beginner / Intermediate level).



## Why this specific score?

Because most medical terminology, drug names, details of anesthesia equipment, and intensive care concepts are taught in English. A student with this level will have the ability to:

- ✓ Easily comprehend lectures and read academic study materials.
- ✓ Understand basic medical vocabulary and terminology faster.
- ✓ Communicate and express scientific concepts during practical training.



**Note for New Students:** If your current level is below this average, do not worry! Focus will be placed on developing medical terminology gradually during the first year.
