



# English Language Requirements and Recommendations



## Is submitting an English certificate (IELTS) required for admission?

**No**, neither the Ministry of Higher Education nor the Institute requires an IELTS certificate as an official prerequisite for application or admission to the department.



## Recommended (Assumed) Score

The student is expected to possess a linguistic proficiency level equivalent to at least **4.5 - 5.0** in the IELTS test (High Beginner / Intermediate level).



## Why this specific score?

Because epidemiology, public health principles, environmental health, biostatistics, primary healthcare concepts, and health survey reports are taught in English. A student with this level will have the ability to:

- ✦ Easily comprehend community health lectures and study academic materials.
- ✦ Understand epidemiological terminology, disease prevention concepts, and health statistics faster.
- ✦ Analyze health data, write field reports, and communicate scientific concepts during practical community training.

### **Note for New Students**

If your current level is below this average, do not worry! Focus will be placed on developing public and community health terminology gradually during the first year.
