



English Language Requirements and Recommendations



Is submitting an English certificate (IELTS) required for admission?

No, neither the Ministry of Higher Education nor the Institute requires an IELTS certificate as an official prerequisite for application or admission to the department.



Recommended (Assumed) Score

The student is expected to possess a linguistic proficiency level equivalent to at least **4.5 - 5.0** in the IELTS test (High Beginner / Intermediate level).



Why this specific score?

Because emergency medical procedures, resuscitation protocols (CPR/BLS/ACLS), trauma management, life support equipment, and triage codes are taught in English. A student with this level will have the ability to:

- ✦ Easily comprehend emergency medicine lectures and study academic materials.
- ✦ Understand emergency care protocols, trauma response terminology, and critical condition terminology faster.

✨ Operate life-support medical equipment interfaces and communicate scientific terms rapidly during practical field training.

💡 **Note for New Students**

If your current level is below this average, do not worry! Focus will be placed on developing emergency medical terminology gradually during the first year. 🚀
