

English Language Requirements and Recommendations

Is submitting an English certificate (IELTS) required for admission?

No, neither the Ministry of Higher Education nor the Institute requires an IELTS certificate as an official prerequisite for application or admission to the department.

Recommended (Assumed) Score

The student is expected to possess a linguistic proficiency level equivalent to at least **4.5 - 5.0** in the IELTS test (High Beginner / Intermediate level).

Why this specific score?

Because pharmaceutical terminology, drug scientific names, chemical compositions, pharmacology concepts, and prescription reading are taught in English. A student with this level will have the ability to:

- ✦ Easily comprehend pharmaceutical lectures and read academic study materials.
- ✦ Understand pharmacology concepts, drug classifications, and medical terminology faster.
- ✦ Accurately read prescriptions and communicate scientific terms during practical lab training.

If your current level is below this average, do not worry! Focus will be placed on developing medical and pharmaceutical terminology gradually during the first year.
