



English Language Requirements and Recommendations



Is submitting an English certificate (IELTS) required for admission?

No, neither the Ministry of Higher Education nor the Institute requires an IELTS certificate as an official prerequisite for application or admission to the department.



Recommended (Assumed) Score

The student is expected to possess a linguistic proficiency level equivalent to at least **4.5 - 5.0** in the IELTS test (High Beginner / Intermediate level).



Why this specific score?

Because medical imaging techniques (X-Ray, CT Scan, MRI, Ultrasound), radiological physics, sectional anatomy, and diagnostic imaging software interfaces are taught in English. A student with this level will have the ability to:

- ✦ Easily comprehend radiology lectures and study academic materials.
- ✦ Understand radiological physics concepts, radiation safety terminology, and anatomical positions faster.
- ✦ Operate imaging equipment software interfaces and accurately follow diagnostic procedures during practical training.

Note for New Students

If your current level is below this average, do not worry! Focus will be placed on developing radiological and medical terminology gradually during the first year.
